### 2. Previous Minutes

### 3. Matters Arising

- Community Council Members Lorraine Cran and Chris Turner have stepped down.

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Chair thanks Lorraine and Chris for their time and work given to the Community Council. Currently without secretary so any volunteers for that role or to take meeting minutes would be appreciated.

- Update – garages at Mackay Road.

Update from JH on garages. Some garages flattened in storm. Area has been tidied up and a lamppost moved. Question from PW – what about remaining garages? JH – Unknown but will find out.

- Update – Play parks – quotes coming in – CRF application.

SW updated on play park information gathered previously including the child consultation carried out by Lynn Macgilvary at Highland Council. EOI for CRF submitted after last meeting. Application has now been submitted for CRF. Quotes have been obtained from play equipment providers.

CRF funding will be decided in February. JH advised that Ward Discretionary Budget still has funding ~£10k available until end of March but applications should be in by end of January to allow for time taken for application review.

SW raised question about whether funding should be sought for a gardener or garden services to plan and maintain planters. Those present in support of doing so.

- Events. Events are to raise awareness of CC and to raise funds, discussed at previous meeting.

- o January event

Burns night quiz, Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026 at the Three Witches. Events committee, SO, SW, SWy, AT, will continue to organise.

- o Spring Clean-up. Planned for March or April, SW asked for dates to avoid.

Weekend of Inverness Half Marathon to be avoided. Community Centre willing to provide teas and coffees etc. Organising Committee – SW, AT, AC Brownies and Guides would be willing to be involved again.

AC updated on areas now being cleaned up and cut back, improving the area and hopefully encouraging others to continue.

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SW has been in contact with the artist who creating the work outside Community Centre who will be looking at this in January with a view to repairing.

- White lines – Car parking – Evan Barron Road/Balloan Road  
PW – lining in car parks in Evan Barron Road, Balloan Road are worn to non-existent. JH to see if this can be done. AT raised possibility of white lining in Milton, but these are owned by Cairn
- Funding ask Girl Guides Guide Camp 2026, was raised at previous meeting. County camp for Guiding Inverness-shire at Badagush. Guides are also doing a practice camp as many have not been away, particularly those affected during Covid. Looking for £2800 to cover remaining amount after their own fund raising, agreed unanimously by community councillors to fund this.
- Pavement sweeper. Looking for additional sweeping in the Community Centre area and through Castle Heather Park. JH advised that Highland Council have another sweeper being allocated to HMCH CC area so will increase pavement sweeping in the area.

- Tomatin road shops. Restoration of shops completion in February 2026, looking for a tenant for vacant shop
- Morvich Way lighting  
Communication from Isabelle Mackenzie updating about 25-49 Morvich Way. 2 lampposts not functional, still not repaired, Isabelle will continue dealing with this. SSEN are involved as there is a cable fault. Jackie Hendry has followed up on Morvich Way but not heard back, two other faults have been repaired.

- Hilton Court does not have a drop kerb, JH working with Ian Brown to try and get that done.
